This Bid Bulletin #01-GOODS-2021 is issued to clarify and/or modify or amend the requirements in the Bidding Documents. This shall form an integral part of the Bidding Process.

- i. The standard admin fee of not less than 20% of the total contract price, as stipulated in DOLE D.O. No. 150-16, is not applicable for this project since the GPPB has issued a resolution that the foregoing order runs counter to the provisions of Section 31 of RA No. 9184 and its IRR.
- ii. The number of days per year to be used in Average Pay per month is 393.5 days.
- iii. The contract duration is changed from one (1) year to *three (3) years*, the Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) is for the first year only.
- iv. Delivery of Services shall begin on June 01, 2022.
- v. The following paragraphs are added to the Technical Specifications:

The service provider/contractor shall maintain a satisfactory level of performance throughout the term of the contract based on a prescribed set of performance criteria. The performance criteria to be applied shall include, among others, the following: (i) quality of service delivered; (ii) time management; (iii) management and suitability of personnel; (iv) contract administration and management; and (v) provision of regular progress reports.

Before end of each year, procuring entities shall conduct an assessment or evaluation of the performance of the service provider/contractor based on the prescribed set of performance criteria.
